

Report from the PRECINCT & PRAETORIAN joint stakeholder workshop

PRECINCT and PRAETORIAN co-organized a stakeholders engagement workshop on 22 November in Brussels. It was a full day event which took place in “Maison des associations internationales”. 75 people attended the workshop in-person, while online participation was also available.

After a short welcome message, the morning session continued with presentation of the first-year results and highlights of each project, by the PRECINCT and PRAETORIAN coordinators. Then, Nora Oufi (PhD student at EDF) presented the human aspect of CI projection in crisis management. The

morning session finished with an overview of the PRECINCT living labs and PRAETORIAN pilot scenarios, presented by Eva Munoz (Spanish pilot scenario), Frederic Guyomard (French scenario) and Tamara Hadjina (Croatian scenarios).

After the lunch break, three working groups took place simultaneously. The PRAETORIAN partners and stakeholders participated in the following working groups:

- The “Standardisation & Policy Recommendations”, which was organized by the PRECINCT team (Giacomo Bianchi) and included a panel discussion in which Tamara Hadjina from the PRAETORIAN project participated.
- The “PRAETORIAN Training & Capacity Building”, organized by the PRAETORIAN team (Lazaros Papadopoulos), which allowed the participants to get familiarized with the PRAETORIAN system. 10 stakeholders joined the workshop, including participants from Metropolitan de Lisboa, Konnecta systems, Transporter Industry International and several end users from the PRAETORIAN consortium. The participants provided feedback through a questionnaire about the usability of the PRAETORIAN system and its impact.

Finally, the PRAETORIAN partners were involved in interesting discussions with the PRECINCT partners during the exploitation and conclusions slots. The discussions focused on challenges in CI protection, such as the availability of data to enable the effective use of digital twins and the availability of tools.

This event was the second successful joint workshop (after the PCSCI workshop in August 2022). The two sister projects already plan new joint events in 2023.
